Dear Trust member,

As the new season is now in full swing the role of the Fans' Trust in providing a loud and clear voice for supporters has never been more important, as endorsed by James Brent himself in our recent Q&A session.

The Argyle Fans' Trust is holding its second AGM on Saturday 24th November, prior to the Chesterfield match, commencing at 11.00 a.m. The venue, and a full agenda, will be announced closer to the event. The AGM will allow the Trust Board to formally report on the Trust's activities, while providing a platform for all members to play an active part in determining the Trust's future priorities. The AGM is open to all Trust members and is free to attend.

As before, a vital part of our agenda is the opportunity for you, the members, to put forward your own motions which can be voted on by fellow members. Motions can be submitted via the Trust's website or sent by post to the Trust Secretary (c/o 43 Balland Park, Ashburton, Devon, TQ13 7BT). Motions must include the name and membership number of the nominator and seconder, and a brief description of the motion and the precise wording to be voted on. Please note the deadline for submission is Saturday 3rd November 2012.

The next step in the critical path towards the AGM will be the publication of the final agenda including a comprehensive list of all tabled motions which will be available for perusal by all members via the Trust website two weeks prior to the AGM.

The AGM will also encompass the election of Society Board members which will allow each member to have their say on the make-up of the Trust board for the next twelve months. The board currently comprises four elected members and two co-optee members. The board has decided to increase its size to seven elected members to add extra resource to more readily ensure the Trust can achieve its objectives and undertake the required activities to do so.
