1.	Apologies were received from Anthony Sherlock
2.	The minutes of the last meeting were accepted
3.	Membership was reported as stable with approximately 800
4.	It was hoped that communications would further improve with the adoption of a new AFT website
5.	The Treasurer's report showed there was £10,439.43 in the bank, with £2,326.33 held in PayPal. This is in line with our commitment to maintain a minimum balance of £10,000
6.	It was agreed to make a £1,000 contribution towards supporting the Northern Ireland Milk Cup
7.	It was decided that the value of the AFT sponsoring game did not match the cost
8.	However the AFT would this year sponsor two players' kits. These would be Sonny Bradley again, plus one to be decided
9.	Additionally the AFT agreed to sponsor one or two of the Plymouth Argyle Ladies Team
10	The Board remained committed to our high quality fanzine, but would closely monitor the print run
