Plymouth Argyle fans are advised that an election is to be held for Members of the Board of the Argyle Fans' Trust (Plymouth Argyle Supporters' Society Limited). There are **five** seats available.

This is a Pre-Election Notice only: the formal process will begin with the 'Notice of Election' being published on the AFT web site on Saturday 28th September.

Anyone wishing to be a candidate or a voter at the election must be aged 16 or over and a fully paid up member of the Argyle Fans' Trust by Friday 27th September. From Saturday 28th September, nomination forms and guidance on candidate statements will be made available to Trust members and may be downloaded from the Trust website. Candidates must submit their completed nomination papers and statements by post or email as directed on the form by 5pm on Thursday 17th October.

If **six** or more candidates submit nominations for the election, ballot papers will be posted to registered members of the Argyle Fans' Trust from Friday 25th October. The deadline for return will be Friday 22nd November by post, or by hand at the commencement of the Trust AGM which will be held at 5.15pm on Saturday 23rd November at the Life Centre opposite Home Park stadium.

The result of the election will be announced at the AGM or as soon as possible afterwards and published on the Argyle Fans' Trust website on Monday 25th November.
